



Background: we have run many Flat and National Hunt racing syndicates over the past years.

During this time we have had numerous wins and huge successes. One of the most notable being with the horse Stone of Folca owned by the Folkestone Racecourse Owners Group. He clocked up the fastest time ever recorded in the 2012 Epsom Dash on Derby Day, to become the fastest horse in the world. He still retains his title and is in the Guinness Book of Records. Another wonderful achievement was Berrahri winning the **Grand Prix** at the prestigious 'White Turf' Meeting in St Moritz in Switzerland on the snow-covered frozen lake in 2019. More recently, Jumbeau, the LPOG21 filly trained by Tom Clover won on her racecourse debut & finished third at York in a **Listed** race on her second start, picking up **Black Type**. Cheng Gong provided our first winner over hurdles and stable mate Cuban Court won on his racecourse debut. Another winning filly is Cluain Aodha who won over hurdles at Warwick earlier this year. Trainer James Owen produced My Gift to You to perfection when winning on his debut for us at Southwell before winning on the bounce with his debut over fences.

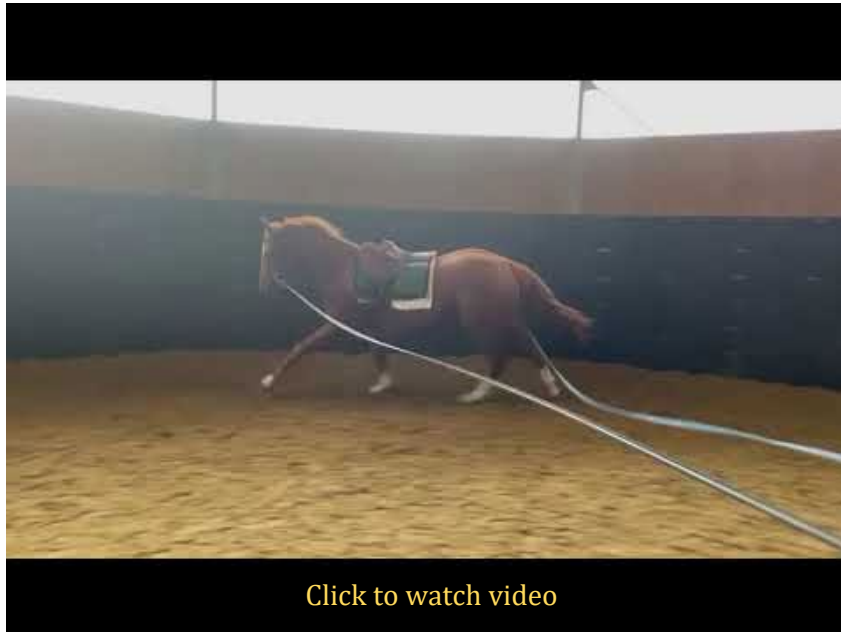


The colt is by top class sprinter with a sire's pedigree, Washington DC who **won** the **Listed** Windsor Castle Stakes, Ascot at 2 and 2nd in the **Gr 1** Pheonix Stakes, Curragh. At 3 he was the top rated 3yo sprinter in Ireland **winning** both the **Listed** Committed Stakes, Navan and the Patton Stakes, Dundalk with numerous **Group** placings including 2nd in the **Gr 1** Prix de l'Abbaye, Chantilly. As a 4yo he **won** the **Gr3** Pheonix Sprint Stakes, Curragh. He was rated 121 by Timeform "well made horse; very smart performer". Aiden O'Brien commented that "he's very fast, he travelled well and he quickened well ... he's all speed".

The dam Aerosphere **won** as a 2yo from only 2 starts and is the dam of 1 runner from 1 foal of racing age who has placed 3 times. The 2nd dam has produced 6 **winners** from 7 runners, whilst the 3rd dam has produced 4 **winners** from 9 runners including Illuminate **winner** of **Gr2** Duchess of Cambridge Stakes, **Gr3** Albany Stakes and placed 2nd in **Gr1** Cheveley Park Stakes as well as producing a **winner** in her own right.
