



Background: we have run many Flat and National Hunt racing syndicates over the past years. During this time we have had numerous wins and huge successes. One of the most notable being with the horse Stone of Folca owned by the Folkestone Racecourse Owners Group. He clocked up the fastest time ever recorded in the 2012 Epsom Dash on Derby Day, to become the fastest horse in the world. He still retains his title and is in the Guinness Book of Records. Another wonderful achievement was Berrahri winning the **Grand Prix** at the prestigious 'White Turf' Meeting in St Moritz in Switzerland on the snow-covered frozen lake in 2019. Jumbeau, the LPOG21 filly trained by Tom Clover won on her racecourse debut & finished third at York in a **Listed** race on her second start, picking up **Black Type**. Cheng Gong provided our first winner over hurdles and stable mate Cuban Court won on his racecourse debut. More recently My Gift To You trained by James Owen won an impressive 4 races for us in under 6 months. Newsreader and Cinque Verde joined My Gift to You providing winning starts to 2024 for their owners.

Trainer Comment "I recently bought One Big Bang a son of Masked Marvel who I believe will turn into an exciting winter horse for the 2024/2025 season. My plan would be to run him in a qualifying race for the ARC 2m 4f Novice Handicap Final at the end of September. Qualifying races run from May and all being well we will aim him for the final which is worth £75,000 followed by a winter campaign. His handicap mark in the UK would be 106 and I am confident this is a mark that we will see lots of

improvement from," explained James Owen, Newmarket.

Sire Comment

He's by Masked Marvel a **St Leger winner** from good, stout German family of Waldpark. He **won** on racecourse debut following up with three further **wins** the Goodwood **Listed Cockeyed Hat Stakes** over 1m 3f, the **Gr3 Bahrain Trophy** over 1m 5f on the July course at Newmarket and the **Gr1 St Leger Stakes** at Doncaster over 1m 6 1/2f with a prize fund of over £422,000. As a sire he's already produced **Gr1** prolific **winner** Teahupoo, **Listed** and **Cheltenham winner** Maskada and another prolific **winner** in Geromino. His stats stack up well with 46-43% winners/runners over jumps/hurdles/chase fences respectively.

Dam Comment

The dam Boston Du Berlais is top class stayer and **winner** of the **Irish St Leger** Turgeon who then became a high class sire of jumpers including **multiple winners** Exotic Dancer rated 177 and Pic D'Orhy rated 162.

His Point to Point analysis in Ireland reads *"One Big Bang is in fact a grey son of Masked Marvel who, although failing to complete on both occasions, had shaped with promise prior to his effort here particularly when carried out when very much in contention in Ballyarthur last May behind Our Champ. Always in the front rank here under Finny Maguire, he travelled nicely into this contest until he was asked for his effort from shortly before two out. From here, his fine jumping allowed him to gain a narrow advantage after the last before staying on notably well in tough underfoot conditions on the run-in. This youngster will no doubt have gained plenty of confidence from his first completed start and he is readily taken to develop into a track winner over intermediate to staying trips in due course'.*
