This colt impressed Newmarket Trainer Kevin Philippart de Foy and is exactly the type of stamp that he looks for in a yearling. Following his two wins, he's being freshened up prior to his summer campaign with 7f races in the middle of April at Newmarket or Newbury targeted before stepping up in trip middle of May or June.

Sire Comment: Royal Ascot **Norfolk Stakes winner.** He is the sire of dual Gr 2 winner The Lir Jet in his first crop who broke the track record on his debut at Yarmouth and then went on to win the **Norfolk Stakes** and the **Franklin-Simpson Stakes.** He has a 38% runners to winners strike rate.

Dam Comment: **Dual winner** and placed 8 times. Dam of **4 winners** from 4 runners and 7 foals of racing age.
